Call for Paper: Unsupervised Clustering for Exploratory Data Analysis Invited Session 32

One of the emerging areas related to the data mining of huge data sets is that of unsupervised exploration. In this way it is possible to extract correlated information from data. Unsupervised clustering is the most used and up to date methodology proposed in literature and many application can be found in very important applicative areas such as Bioinformatics, Astronomy, Geophysics, etc.. In this session there will be presented both theoretical and applicative papers.

Paper submission

All submissions will be refereed by experts in the field based on originality, significance, quality and clarity. Every submitted paper will be reviewed by at least two members of the Program Committee. Papers must be prepared according to the LNCS-LNAI style template (<http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html>) and must be no more than eight (8) pages long, including figures and bibliography. They should be submitted in PDF using the *PROSE Invited Session Paper Submission System* (<http://www.prosemanager1.co.uk/kes2008is/submitpaper.asp>), and selecting the *Invited Session IS 32: Unsupervised Clustering for Exploratory Data Analysis*. It is intended that the conference proceedings will be published by Springer in LNCS/LNAI. Extended versions of selected papers will be considered for publication in the KES Journal. Authors will be limited to one paper per registration.
